

Priestly Formation



- Tuition, room, and board for a seminarian working towards his B.A. in Philosophy is \$39,554 per year; and tuition, room, and board for a seminarian working towards his Master of Divinity and Master of Arts degrees is \$41,889 per year.
- Costs for health insurance, books, and additional expenses for seminarians can reach \$8,500 per year.

ANSWERING THE CALL


Newly Ordained Priest

“ My experience at Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary, looking back, is filled with profound gratitude. When entering the seminary, you quickly learn what you don't know. 
